SECURITY SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT ANNOUNCES INTRODUCTION OF A 2010 ADA COMPLIANT DEPOSITORY UNIT

CINCINNATI, OH March 29, 2011, For Immediate Release—Security Systems Equipment Corporation (SSE) recently announced the introduction of a hopper-style, manually operated after hours/night depository, which meets or exceeds the new pull requirements outlined in the **2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design**. Daniel P. Grabowski, SSE's vice president sales and marketing stated, “We believe this is the first depository unit of its type to be compliant with the 2010 ADA requirements.”

According to the new standard, depositories installed on or after March 15, 2012 must ensure that the force required to activate operable parts shall be 5 pounds maximum. Drive-up-only depositories, however, will be exempt from this force requirement.

SSE's President, Ross Bushman stated, “We are very proud of the fact that our staff was able to design and build a unit in such a short period of time that allows us not just to meet the new standard, but to exceed it.” He went on to explain, “Most current manually operated, hopper-style depositories can require up to 20 pounds or more to activate operable parts. Our new patent pending design needs less than 5 pounds of force *at any time* throughout the entire opening cycle to effectively conduct a transaction.”

In addition to a unit designed for use on new installations, Mr. Grabowski also reported, “We have also developed models that can be used to replace most existing hopper style depository units that have been installed in the past 20 years. This includes hopper assemblies, such as those used in the NCR 5285 Business Depository, as well as various other style heads from other manufacturers. We have already been contacted by a number of financial institutions who have an interest in upgrading older sites even though they may not be required to do so under the 2010 ADA Standards.”

“This depository is only the latest in a long line of product innovations SSE has introduced,” Mr. Bushman continued, “that are designed to allow financial institutions to offer customer-friendly services while either meeting regulatory guidelines or environmental concerns.” For example, last spring SSE introduced its new IXT line of drive-up/lobby remote transaction systems that use powder coatings so no VOCs (Volatile Organic Compounds) are released into the environ-

ment during the manufacturing process, and are also RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive) compliant reducing pollution concerns both in manufacturing and at end-of-life.
