In order to ensure a seamless transition for customers, Triton and ATMGurus will be gradually relocating the parts, repair, and training facilities to Long Beach, MS between now and year-end.

Daryl Cornell, Chief Executive Officer, said, "The success of ATMGurus in providing our customers with a single source of multi-brand parts, repair and training services has exceeded our every expectation. The expansion and relocation of ATMGurus to Long Beach represents the next stage of development for ATMGurus as we increase our service levels in all areas."

As a result of the move, Triton's Long Beach facility and staff will be expanded, improving efficiencies, providing room for growth and increasing customer service levels.
